



Jean-Willy Kunz is the Organist in Residence of the Montreal Symphony Orchestra. In addition to playing both with the Orchestra and in recital, he sees to the development and showcasing of the pipe organ installed in 2014 at the Maison symphonique in Montréal.

Jean-Willy Kunz' interest and versatility in different styles of music are reflected in the various projects he has been involved with for the last ten years, and which shed new light on the pipe organ, including jazz music in duo with Branford Marsalis, pop music with Rufus Wainwright, stage music with the Cirque du Soleil, and the first ever Earth-Space organ duet in collaboration with the NASA.

He is organ professor at the Conservatory of Music in Montréal, titular organist at the church of St-Jean-Baptiste, as well as Artistic Director of the Canadian International Organ Competition.
