Vice-Regal Patronage

Beginning with His Excellency Earl Grey in 1909, and continuing to the present day, each successive Governor General of Canada has served as Patron of the Royal Canadian College of Organists. The present Patron is His Excellency The Right Honourable David Johnston, CC, CMM, COM, CD, FRSC(hon) FRCPSC(hon) Governor General of Canada.

Honorary Patrons

Two eminent British musicians served as Patrons of the Canadian Guild of Organists and Canadian College of Organists, forerunners of the RCCO. Professor Sir J Frederick Bridge, CVO, MA, MusDoc, FRCO, served as Patron from 1909 until his death on March 18, 1924. Sir Walter Parratt, CVO, MA, MusDoc, served as Patron until his death nine days after Sir Frederick, on March 27, 1924. Distinguished musicians Dame Gillian Weir DBE and Angela Hewitt OC, OBE presently serve as Honorary Patrons.
