

R.C.C.O. EXAMINATION SCHOLARSHIPS

The following scholarships and prizes are available to be awarded each year based on the results of the examinations. In order to be eligible for a scholarship or prize, a candidate must pass all requirements for the examination at the same session and the average of the marks obtained in the Practical and Written sections must be at least 75%. For those prizes based on one section or part of the examination, a mark of at least 75% must be obtained in that particular section or part.

The Willan Scholarships

\$800 for the highest mark in the Fellowship examination.

\$700 for the highest mark in the Associateship examination.

The Kathleen Williams Scholarships

\$400 for the highest mark in the Colleague examination.

\$200 for the highest mark in the Service Playing examination.

The John Sidgwick Memorial Scholarship

\$1,000 for the highest mark in the Professional Diploma in Choral Conducting, to be applied to further studies in choral conducting. This will be given to the candidate on presentation of proof of registration in an accredited course in choral conducting within the following four years.

The Wayne C. Vance Scholarship

Awarded to the candidate for the Associateship examination who sits the examination in Ontario and achieves the highest average mark, or if there is no such eligible candidate, the candidate for the Fellowship examination who sits the examination in Ontario and achieves the highest average mark, or if there is no such eligible candidate, the candidate for the Associateship examination who achieves the highest average mark, or if there is no such eligible candidate, the candidate for the Fellowship examination who achieves the highest average mark. The amount of the scholarship is determined annually based on the performance of the endowed funds invested for this purpose, but is expected to be in the range of \$500.

The Rollinson Prize

\$200 for the highest mark in the Written section of the Associateship.

The Charles Peaker Prize

The prize consists of Volumes 1 and 2 of *Organ Music in Canada* and is awarded to the second-place overall successful candidates in the Associateship and Fellowship examinations.

The Doreen Porter Prize

\$300 for the highest mark in the Test portion of the Practical section of the Fellowship examination.

The Ruth & Ralph Barker Prize

\$250 for the highest mark in the Test portion of the Practical section of the Associateship examination.

The Heather Spry Prize

\$300 for the highest mark in the Written section of the Fellowship examination.
